Local students and Nugget Markets associates receive CGA and the Eugene and Joan Stille educational scholarships

Woodland CA - Nugget Markets associates Sarah Engstrom and Samuel England have been awarded the \$2,000 CGA Don Beaver Memorial Scholarship and the \$1,000 Eugene and Joan Stille Educational Scholarship, respectively. A graduate of Christian Brothers High School, Engstrom is employed as a courtesy clerk at the Woodland Nugget Markets location and this fall she'll be attending California State University, Chico, majoring in business and management. England, whose mom is a long-time Nugget Markets associate, graduated from Woodland Christian High School and will be a freshman at UC Davis this fall, majoring in entomology.

Two Eugene and Joan Stille Educational Scholarships (\$1,000 each) are available to high school seniors or undergraduate students employed by Nugget Markets or Food 4 Less. or is a dependent of an associate. Dependents of Nugget Markets or Food 4 Less executives, store directors and corporate directors are not eligible and only one recipient per family is awarded. The grocery industry offers more than 200 grocery industry scholarships. High school seniors or undergraduate students who are employed by a CGA member (like Nugget Market, Inc.) or whose parent is employed by a CGA member are eligible for scholarship awards. Graduate students pursuing a grocery industry career and who are employed by a CGA member are also eligible.

“The friendly culture here at Nugget has inspired me to really learn about business,” says Engstrom. “I’ve gained so much by helping and communicating with our guests and associates throughout the store, and my experience here at Nugget has really solidified my interest in the business world.”
